



Glenmoriston Shooting Ground

Run by shooters for shooters

Please observe the following guidelines:

A shooting slot **MUST** be booked in advance by contacting the COVID Officer (Shona). If you are unable to attend, please notify her as soon as possible so that your slot may be allocated to someone else.

Please do not turn up at the ground without booking in advance – you will not be allowed to shoot if you do so. Non-shooting guests are also not permitted at this time.

You should report to the office on arrival at the ground where you will be required to provide a contact telephone number for Scottish Government Test and Protect. If this is your first visit to the ground in 2021 you **MUST** complete the club disclaimer form.

A one-way system is in place through the clubhouse so that you can access the office and toilets safely. Please sanitise hands on entry and exit. Face coverings should be worn indoors.

A maximum of 15 persons can be on the ground for the shooting period. Squads for ABT, DTL and OT can have 5 shooters. For ABT and OT you should stand at the marked position when moving between pegs in order to maintain a 2m distance.

Please wipe down on/off switches and control units using the provided wipes and sanitise your hands after touching.

You are required to maintain strict social distancing at all times in line with Scottish Government guidelines.

You are required to take **ALL** rubbish, including empty cartridge cases and boxes away with you - there will be no bins provided on the ground.

Practice can be paid on the day using cash, cheque or by contactless card payment. At the moment there will be no catering or refreshments available on site.

Please leave the ground within 15 minutes of the end of shooting time.

Please remember that these guidelines have been put in place not only for your safety, but also for the ground staff.
