

COMPETITION RULES – OT/ABT in addition to the Ground's General Guidance

Please arrive at the ground in time to be ready to shoot at the published time.

To avoid gatherings outside the clubhouse, please come to the office to pay your entry (if you have not already done so in advance) when you can see that there is a minimum number of people waiting.

When changing pegs, please move to the off-set cone until the next peg is empty to ensure 2m distancing.

When moving from peg 5 to 1 please ensure you observe 2m distancing from the other competitors, referee and scorer.

When you finish shooting each round, please confirm your score on the visual score board and card with the referee and scorer.

From each squad, three shooters will be required to referee and score the following squad – disposable gloves will be provided.

There will be no prize giving on the day with the exception of any trophy which can be collected from the office. Prize monies can be collected from the ground when you next visit.

Food and light refreshments will be available and can be pre-ordered to help avoid queues. Service will be from the side kitchen door.

Shooters are responsible for removing their spent cartridges, cardboard etc from the range. Whilst the skip is still on the ground you are welcome to empty your rubbish in there.

Please note that these rules are for the safety of both you and the ground staff and comply with the governing body's guidance.

Your co-operation will help the shoot run more smoothly and safely and will be much appreciated.
